

## OMISIÓN DE “THAT”

A menudo podemos omitir la conjunción “that”, especialmente en estilo informal. Más concretamente:

- Cuando “that” es objeto de la “relative clause”:

Those are the people (that) we met in Liverpool > We met *them* in Liverpool  
This is the girl (that) I like > I like *the girl*

Por ejemplo, en este caso no se podría omitir:

This is the car that runs fast > *The car* runs fast

- En estilo indirecto cuando utilizamos uno de los verbos de uso más corriente:

James said (that) he was feeling better  
James replied that he was feeling better  
~~James replied he was feeling better~~

- En expresiones comunes, cuando “that” precede a un adjetivo:

I’m glad (that) you’re all right  
It’s funny (that) he hasn’t written

- Se puede omitir “that” después de “so” y “such”:

I came to see you so (that) you would know the truth  
I was having such a nice time (that) I didn’t want to leave
